



Week #2: Understand the Plan

Relevant Information (Large Group)

- What was one thing that God showed you this past week in your relationship with Him?
- Share a time when you lost something and how you felt when you found it.
- Read Luke 15:1-7. What point is Jesus trying to convey through this story?
- What are some labels that people put on other people when they first see them?
- Read Matthew 9:35-38. How did Jesus see the crowds? Why is that important?
- Why do some Christians avoid being around non-Christians? What are the benefits and drawbacks to this approach?
- Do you find it easy or difficult to publicly acknowledge what Jesus means to you? Why or why not?
- Read Luke 23:32-43. What were most people doing to Jesus in these verses? Why is that important?
- What guidelines for evangelism can we draw from our discussion?
- In light of our discussion, is there an additional insight you would like to discuss further with the group?

Gracious Obedience “Application” (Smaller Groups 2-6 people)

- What is one topic or concept that stood out to you in our discussion tonight?
- How can you apply that topic or concept to your life?

Walking Together (Smaller Groups 2-6 people)

- For those who didn't share last week, briefly share your personal conversion story within your group.

Outreach (Large Group)

- Choose one person that a member of your group knows, who needs to hear about the love of Jesus. Have the group commit to praying for that person this week.
