Relevant Information (Large Group)

- What was one thing that God showed you this past week in your relationship with him?
- Identify some areas in your life where you have received training. What did you learn?
- Read Matthew 10:1-15. What are some things Jesus is asking the Apostles to do and not do? Why did Jesus identify these things in the Apostles preparation to be sent out?
- Identify some training principles in Matthew 10:1-15 that can you can apply to your life as Jesus sends you out to share his love with others.
- Read Luke 15:8-10. What does the woman do to find the coin? Why is this significant?
- What is the woman's reaction to finding the coin? Why is this significant?
- What practical training for sharing Jesus love with others can we draw from our discussion?
- In light of our discussion, is there an additional insight you would like to discuss further with the group?

Gracious Obedience "Application" (Smaller Groups 2-6 people)

- What is one topic or concept that stood out to you in our discussion tonight?
- How can you apply that topic or concept to your life?

Walking Together (Smaller Groups 2-6 people)

- Briefly pick a story, chapter, or section of the Bible and commit to reading those verses sometime this next week individually. As you are reading through the verses, share highlights with your group via text message or email.

Outreach (Large Group)

- Discuss the names of one or two people you plan on inviting to Easter at Grace.
